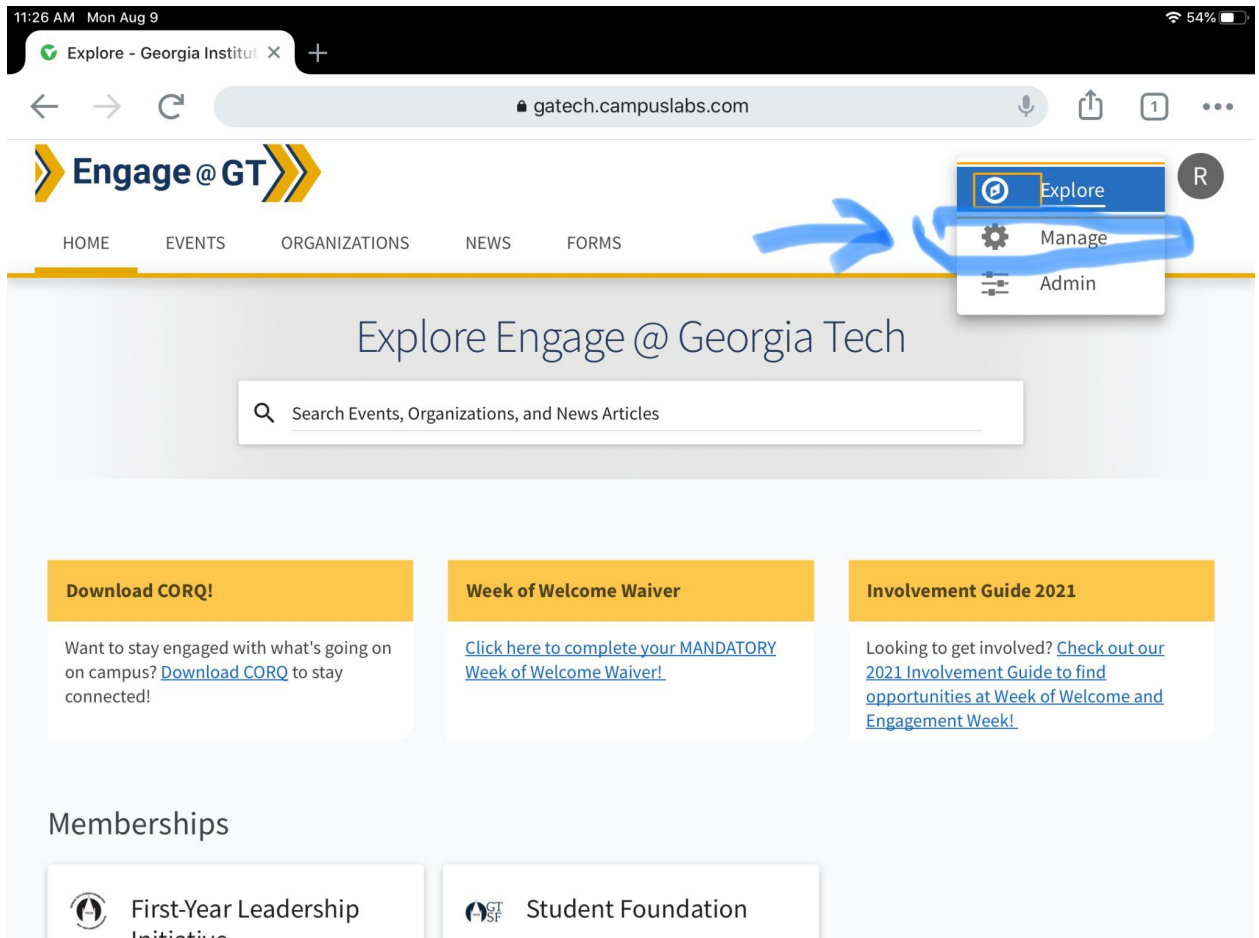


Registered Student Org's Allocation Request

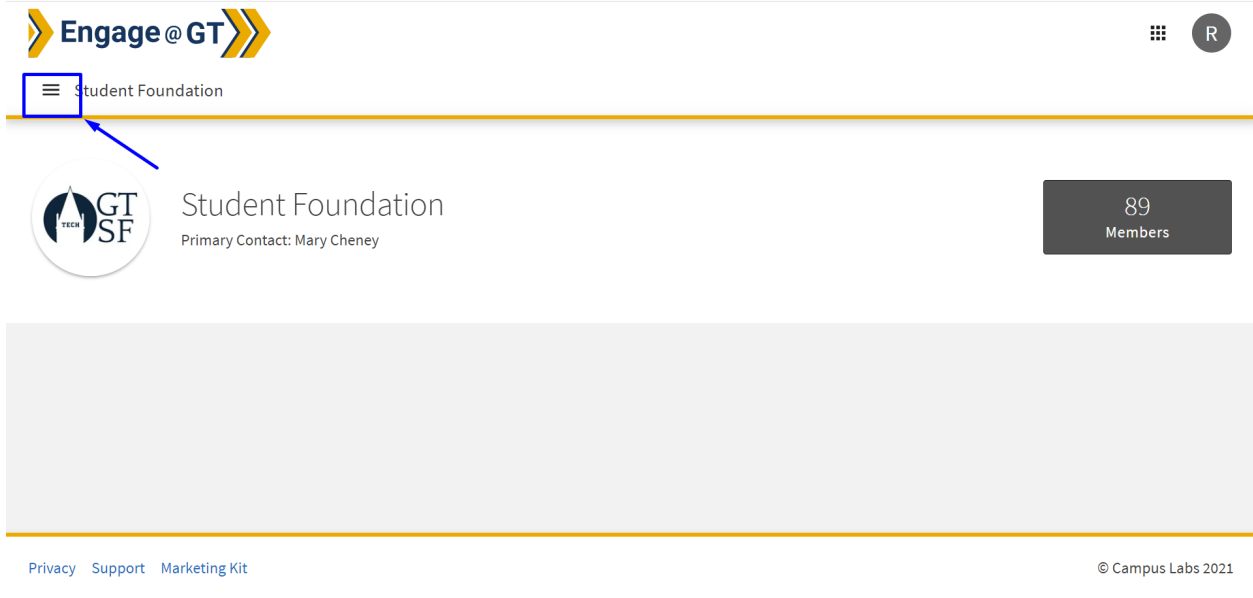

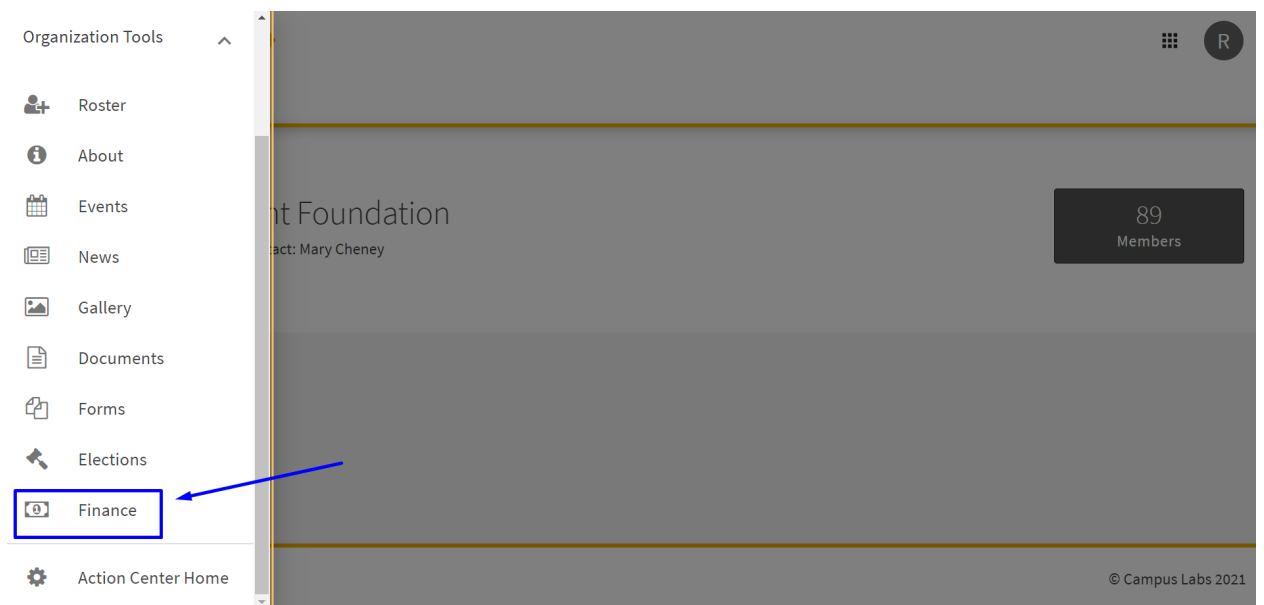

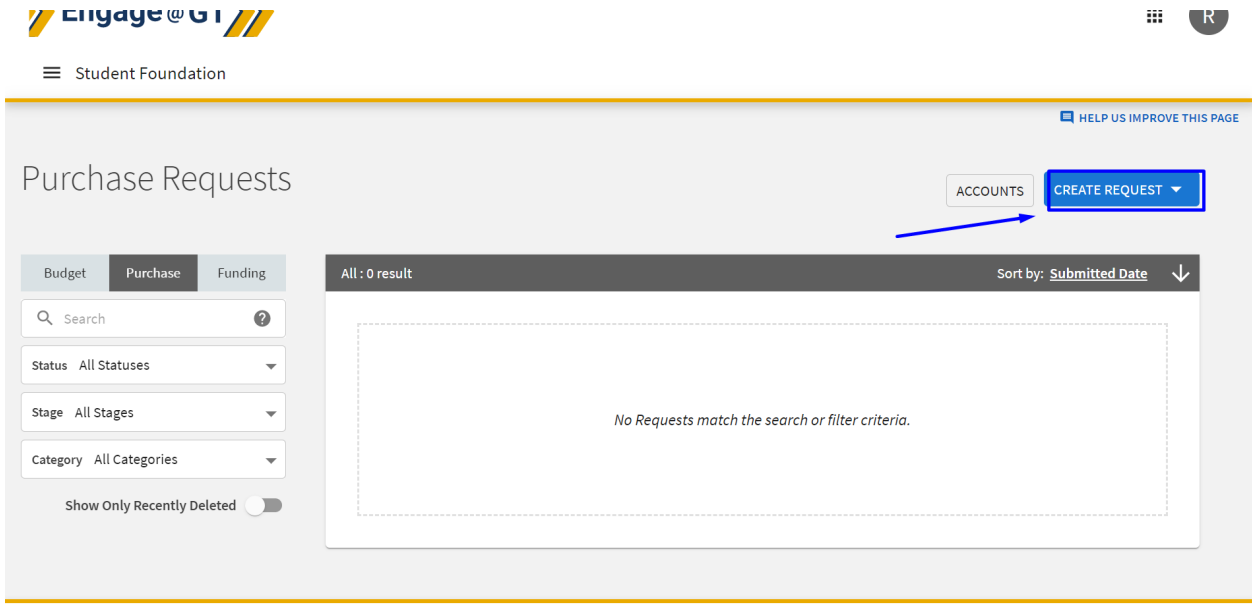
4. From your Org's page click the button in the top left corner to access your orgs navigation tab



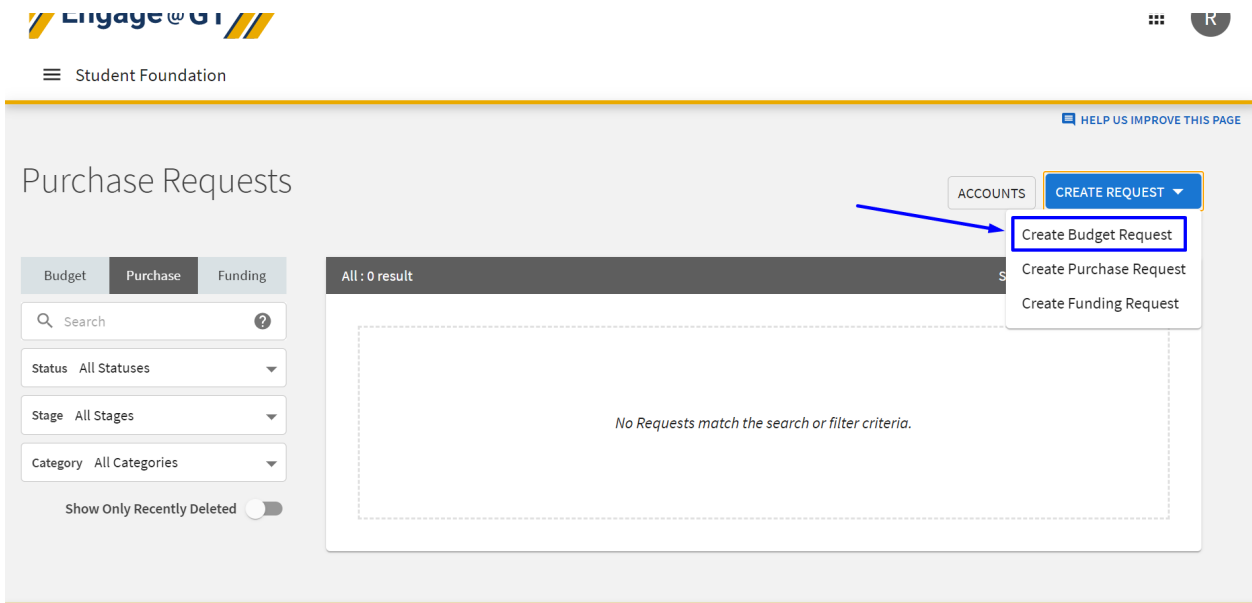
5. Once in your Navigation Tab, click the finance button

Process: GTSF Funding Application Fall 2021

Available from 7/19/21 12:00 AM to 8/6/21 6:00 PM

Each semester, GTSF provides around \$30,000.00 of funding to various student organizations and initiatives from the revenue produced by the student-run endowment which is currently valued at \$1.5 million.

GTSF Funding process consists of two parts: application and presentation. The application is offered once every Fall and Spring semester and open to the entire Georgia Tech community (undergraduate, graduate, and PhD organizations that are registered or unregistered). The 2021 Spring GTSF Funding Application will be open from XX-XX.
